Summer Programs Educator

Part-time, seasonal hourly (25-30 hours/week)
Availability to work: Monday-Friday, either mornings (8:30am-12:30pm) and/or afternoons (12:30pm-4:30pm) during camp weeks

The Fort Collins Museum of Discovery (FCMoD) is seeking enthusiastic educators to lead weeklong children's summer programs.

FCMoD offers a variety of educational summer programs for children ages 3-15. From exploring the outer reaches of our galaxy, to conducting messy science experiments, to dressing up like a pioneer in early Fort Collins, FCMoD's summer programs offer interactive experiences for everyone! This is a part-time, seasonal contract position. You will be assigned to teach certain camps based on your background, interests, and availability. We ask for a commitment of at least 2 weeks and may be able to offer up to 4 weeks.

- Teach two (2) or more weeks during the summer based on your background, interests, and availability.
- Weekly time commitment will be between 25-30 hours/week. Camp dates and times vary but you must be available to teach Monday-Friday, either mornings (8:30am-12:30pm) and/or afternoons (12:30pm-4:30pm) during camp weeks that you are assigned to teach.
- Pay rate is \$10/hour (non-negotiable)
- All program materials, teaching manuals, and training will be provided by FCMoD.
- You must be able to attend a Summer Programs Group Training night (for all staff, teachers, and volunteers) on Wednesday, May 9th from 5pm 7 pm at the museum as well as an individual training session (1-2 hours) to be scheduled with the Summer Programs Coordinator.

ESSENTIAL DUTIES & RESPONSIBILITIES

Education

Summer Programs Educators will inspire camp participants to explore, discover, question, and create! Educators will facilitate dynamic and fun content from FCMoD summer program plans in the unique, informal setting of the museum and by using museum resources. Educators will be flexible and able to respond to the diverse interests of the group while helping participants achieve the objectives of the program.

Professionalism

Summer Programs Educators will represent FCMoD to the highest standard by upholding museum values and by modeling professional behavior and excellent classroom management at all times. Educators will work to create a welcoming, inclusive, and safe environment for all participants and teen volunteers. They will also work collaboratively with FCMoD staff, coeducators, and teen volunteers to provide a cohesive experience and exceptional customer service for the participants.

Organization

Use provided activity plans to prepare collaboratively with co-educators or staff members, prepare duties for teen volunteers, communicate with School Programs Coordinator to ensure program needs are met, gather and prepare supplies for crafts, art projects and/or experiments, and ensure that crafts and/or experiments are set up and cleaned up after each class.

- Enjoys interacting with and engaging school-age students and teen volunteers
- Ability to communicate effectively both orally and in writing
- Be detail-oriented, calm under pressure, and have a discovery mindset
- Ability to work in a fast-paced environment, able to analyze situations, responding quickly to deliver effective solutions
- Ability to establish and maintain effective working relationships with FCMoD staff and teen volunteers

PHYSICAL DEMANDS

While performing the duties of this job, employee is regularly required to stand, walk, and sit; extended periods of walking and moderate physical activity required. - Other direct and relevant experience *may* be considered and substituted for experience and education requirements
